

BREITENBACH PIGEONS

After a long absence of racing pigeons, I started racing again in 2009 the first year I did well, but average. I received 10 babies from Kiewiet in 2010 and the results were amazing. I soon realised that my old birds were no match for the Tom Lock pigeons. In 2011 I finished runner up in the club and 10th union 2012 ,2013 and 2014 the Tom Lock pigeons from Kiewiet were unstoppable unfortunately I had to stop during 2014 due to work related problems.

In 2017 I started again and received 100 youngsters from Kiewiet. I started the first race in 2018 with only yearlings. These 100 pigeons were amazing, I won the Club championship. And were 5th union and Combine. I won 11 club races and 9 union races in that year. In 2019 I ended 2nd club 7th union and Combine. I won the all bird averages with 2000 Points in the union. I am all bird champion in the club, section, union and combine in 2019.

Kiewiet's pigeons make racing easy there is no long distances or short distance pigeons among them they fly from start to finish. Last year a bird Kiewiet bred for me 16907 flew all 18 races in 2019 calendar and where crowned best overall pigeon in the union as a youngster.

Another 1937/2010 won Wolmaransstad at 300km and Three Sisters 960km in 2011 as a youngster.

Last year pigeon ZA0059 / SLIM2017 won Britstown 745km on an overnight race by 75 minutes in the THABAZIMBI Club and second in the Union. (Velocity 903.8562)

What more can I say you can mate them with a water drinker, and they will still breed champions. Kiewiet is a much better breeder than a racer although he won many races his ability to keep his pigeons pure and retain the best genes through a selection process that is second to none is remarkable. You cannot go wrong with these birds as they are decedents from the Slimme Putteries that till this day still are the foundation of SA Pigeons.

Summary:

① BBH4310/2013-Juan2 x Hermien

Grandmother to 1st SA pigeon (16th overall SMDPR 2020). 4310 breeds 2 x winners and many more Club, Fed and Union positions. Children also excellent breeders.

② BBC4316/2014-Juan2 x Hermien

Haven't produced any winners. Children are good racers and breeders.

③ BBC4317/2014-Juan2 x Hermien

My best Tom Lock Cock. Son wins Cradock OLR (10 Hour flight). Breeds many more winners. Children are good racers and particular good breeders.

④ BBH3513/2013-Juan2 x 00115/2011

Produces winners. Children are very consistent racers.

⑤ BBH00115/2011-My best Tom Lock Hen. Lot ④ direct daughter.

This is an exceptional breeder. She has produced many winners. Her children inherits this exceptional gene and also breeds excellent offspring.

⑥ BBWFC10321/2013- R80 000 x 0015/2011

He has bred a couple of winners with a few more worth mentioning positions. Offspring are also good breeders.

To summarise these 6 pigeons in a nutshell. They are exceptional breeders. I will gladly recommend these Tom Locks to any fancier who is serious about the sport of racing pigeons...
